Minutes of Special Meeting of Board of Directors March 14, 2024

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 94 (the "District") met in special session, open to the public on March 14, 2024, in accordance with the duly posted notice of meeting, and the roll was called of the duly constituted members of said Board, as follows:

The President called the meeting to order and declared it open for such business as might regularly come before the Board.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no comments from the public at this time.

CONVERSION OF STREET LIGHTS TO LED LIGHTS

The Board discussed the conversion of street lights being maintained by the District to LED lights, and the approval of any necessary agreements or documentation in connection with same. In that regard, the Board reviewed and discussed a proposed form of street light agreement between the District and CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC. Following discussion, Director Waymel moved that the Board approve the agreement and authorize the President to execute same on behalf of the District, subject to final review of the form by SPH. Director Pachuilo seconded the motion, which unanimously carried.

The Board noted that the anticipated start date for the conversion project is at least one year away, given the number of other communities on the waiting list. Director Rueschhoff advised that additional details on the program will be provided when feasible, and he requested that until such time, Mr. Grobelny simply advise the Association that the agreement and program are pending.

The Board next considered additional items for placement on future agendas. No specific agenda items, other than routine and ongoing matters, were requested.
