Holiday - Republic Services ONLY observes Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

TRASH AND HEAVY TRASH COLLECTIONS - The following items and materials **Will NOT** be accepted

- Dead animals
- Arsenic
- Chemical containers over 5 (five) gallons
- Nuclear/radioactive waste
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Gasoline
- Insecticides
- Pool chemicals
- Sheetrock or drywall
- Solvent
- Power steering fluid
- Anti-Freeze/coolant
- Herbicides
- Pesticides
- Construction/home remodeling debris
- Ammunition or Explosives
- Chemicals not in original containers
- Mercury
- Thermometers
- Unidentified chemicals
- Oil
- Flammable chemicals
- Paint/paint cans
- Varnish/stain
- Batteries
- Transmission fluid
- Used oil filters
- Poison
- Medical waste
- Liquids
- Propane tanks
- Wood or fencing
- Nails
- Tires
- Windows/Doors
- Insulation
- Stone/concrete
- Tree trunks
- Water softeners

- BBQ grills or smokers over 35 pounds

HEAVY TRASH COLLECTION - Heavy Trash/Bulk/Yard Waste Collection – 2 appliances or bulky items and 25 bags or bundles of yard waste per collection – 1xMonth

Acceptable Heavy Trash Items:

Household Appliances

Refrigerators must have Freon drained and be tagged accordingly by a certified technician.

Hot water heaters must be drained. Live Christmas trees.

Furniture. Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes. No propane tanks.

Packing Peanuts:

Packing peanuts may not be offered loose, they must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.

Yard Waste:

Bush and tree trimmings cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter, securely tied in bundles, not to exceed 35 lbs.

All grass clippings, and leaves must be bagged.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Acceptable Recycling Items:

- Paperboard
- Brown paper bags
- Phone books
- Catalogs
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Junk mail
- Tin and steel cans
- Aluminum cans, foil and trays
- Office and school paper
- Cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastics #1, #2, and #5
- Cereal and food boxes

Please rinse bottles, cans, and jars before placing them in the cart.

No food residue. No pizza boxes.
