- TRASH COLLECTION with 96 gal Republic Services Trash Cart Tuesday and Friday.
- **RECYCLING COLLECTION** with 96 gal Republic Services Recycling Cart Every Other Wednesday.
- **HEAVY TRASH and YARD WASTE COLLECTION** 2nd Friday of the Month.
- Have all collections at the curb by 7 a.m. That is when routes begin.
- Place carts 5 feet from any object to insure a safe collection. Close cart lids.
- Republic Services closes for these holidays: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Years Day.

HEAVY TRASH/YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Up to 2 appliances or bulky items and 25 bags or bundles of yard waste per collection day.

Acceptable Heavy Trash Items:

Household Appliances – Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners must have Freon drained and tagged accordingly by a <u>certified</u> technician.

Hot water heaters must be drained.

Live Christmas trees. Cardboard moving boxes – broken down.

Furniture. Mattresses and Box Springs.

Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes. No propane tanks. No toilets.

Packing Peanuts:

Packing peanuts may not be collected loose - must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.

Yard Waste:

Bush and tree trimmings cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter, securely tied in bundles, not to exceed 50 lbs. All grass clippings and leaves must be bagged.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Acceptable Recycling Items:

- Paperboard
- Brown paper bags
- Phone books
- Catalogs
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Junk mail

- Tin and steel cans
- Aluminum cans
- Office and school paper
- Cardboard broken down
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastics #1, #2, #5 and #7
- Cereal and food boxes
- √ Remove food/liquids and rinse recyclables before putting them into the recycling cart.
- ✓ Do not put recyclables in a plastic bag before putting them into the recycling cart.
- ✓ Do not put yard waste in your recycling cart.
- ✓ Do not put anything that isn't listed above in your recycling cart.
